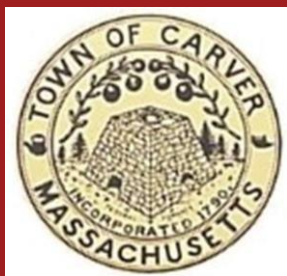




QUICK FACTS:

Client Objectives:

The town of Carver is committed to “Keeping the Earth Green”. Clean, renewable and affordable Solar Electricity Generation on-premise is a critical part of their sustainability mission.

- As a responsible member of the community, The Town of Carver strives to be the industry leader in sustainability
- Lower carbon footprint to reduce their impact and be an environmental friendly township while serving the residents at the highest level
- Cost savings and predictability vs. grid-supplied electricity

SolareAmerica Solution:

SolareAmerica developed the Solar PV System to power 100% of the electricity needs of the Town of Carver Water Department.

SolarSense executed a sale-leaseback transaction with the Developer.

- Solar System Description: 381 kW Solar PV system comprised of: 300 watt Panels; environmentally-friendly ground screws and racking; Solectria Inverters. **Annual Production: 492,000 kWh's**
- Business Model: 7-year Sale and Leaseback Agreement to solar developer
- Financing: Private financing including 1603 Treasury Grant Incentive, ARRA Grant, sponsor equity and 3rd party debt-capital
